To help reduce the spread of COVID-19, MSU Health Care is encouraging patients to consider using Telehealth. Keep your already scheduled appointments, book new visits, and safely see your provider from the comfort of your home.

What is Telehealth?

Telehealth visits are real-time virtual visits with your provider that incorporate audio or video.

What equipment do I need to schedule a Telehealth visit? You will need a phone, tablet or computer. To download our app, follow the instructions Preparing for Your Virtual Visit or visit our website.

What can my doctor treat me for in a Virtual Visit?

Visits such as a routine follow-up, medication refills, and certain illnesses are all examples of visits that can occur through a Telehealth visit. Our schedulers can verify if your visit would be eligible.

How much does a Virtual Visit cost?

Costs are defined by the type of insurance plan you have. Please note that audio-only visits are only covered by specific insurances. If there is a co-pay required by your insurance providers, a bill will be sent to you after your visit. We do have a self-pay option of \$49.95 for those without insurance.
